About the Aerojet facility

- ⤴ The parking lot is less than 100 yards from where all the activity will take place. Everything is either paved, cemented, or manicured, flat grass.
- ⤴ Three ponds, which will be planted with trout, will be available for fishing for the **physically challenged child only**. Limit is five fish but if someone is waiting for a rod and a child has already caught three fish, we ask that the child take a rest, take advantage of the many other activities, and then come back later to catch their limit.
- ⤴ The children will be able to fish from the overhang from the cement staging area or from the grassy areas surrounding the ponds. There will be 1:1 supervision available (if requested) from members of California Striped Bass Association.
- ⤴ Wheelchair accessible restrooms are within 20 yards of the ponds. Medical professionals will be on hand.

Other Information

- ⤴ Though this is a family event, again, only the physically challenged child may fish. Siblings are more than welcome to take part in all the other activities.
- ⤴ Fishing tackle and assistance if needed will be provided and all trout caught will be cleaned, bagged and put on ice until you leave.
- ⤴ Food (hot dogs and/or hamburgers, sodas, chips) is served between 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m.
- ⤴ Activities include clowns, magician, face painting, finger painting, karaoke, games, prizes, and much, much more.
- ⤴ It is ALL FREE.
- ⤴ **PLEASE LIMIT PARTICIPANTS TO THE IMMEDIATE FAMILY**

Directions

Take Highway 50 east towards Lake Tahoe. Take Aerojet Road exit. Turn left on Folsom Blvd and then right on Birkmont Drive. Entrance is about 100 yards on the right. Go through the gate and park straight in the back.

If coming from the east, take the Hazel exit, turning left over the freeway. Turn left on Folsom Blvd, then right on Birkmont Drive. Entrance is about 100 yards on the right. Go through the gate and park straight in the back.

(note: Birkmont Drive was formerly called Alabama Road)
